




Anti - Ragging Meeting with Students

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

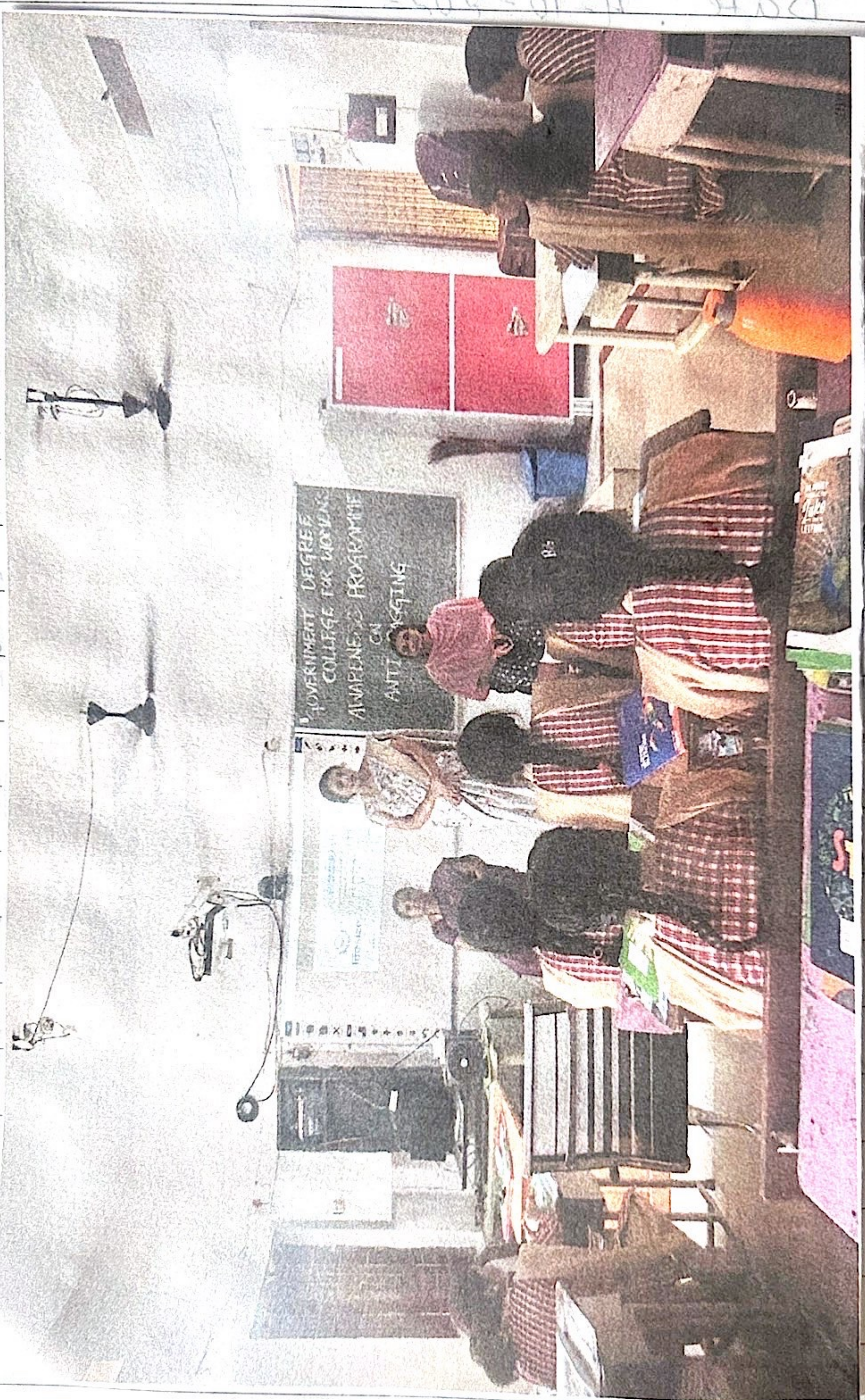


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Awareness Programme on Anti-Ragging
